Dear Sir,

I have the pleasure to inform you that the Government of Belgium, through its Federal Public Service of Foreign Affairs, Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation (DGD), has decided to contribute to:

#### UNICEF,

the amount of 2.500.000 EUR, as a Belgian earmarked contribution (ref. PJ/2018/09), for the humanitarian project 'Rapid Response to Movements Population (RRMP) - 9th Phase' in Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC),

under the Terms and Conditions of the Contribution as stated in this letter.

Please find enclosed a copy of the Ministerial Decree awarding 2.500.000 EUR to UNICEF.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRIBUTION

#### 1. Accordance with the Framework Arrangement

**1.1** All the provisions applicable to earmarked contributions to humanitarian programmes/projects of the Framework Arrangement signed between UNICEF and the Government of Belgium on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2016, apply to the present Terms and Conditions of the Contribution.

# 2. Payment conditions

2.1 The payment of the contribution will be done into UNICEF's bank account:

- 2.2 The contribution will be paid in one installment upon receipt of:
  - UNICEF's written acceptance of the terms and conditions described in this letter. UNICEF's written acceptance has to state UNICEF's bank account for payment, as mentioned above under 2.1, and has to state a formal claim for the payment of the contribution.
- 2.3 This letter of the Belgian Minister for Development Cooperation, the written acceptance by UNICEF of the terms and conditions specified in this letter, and the written project proposal 'Rapid Response to Movements Population (RRMP) 9th Phase' (in DRC), constitute the specific agreement for the award and use of the contribution.
- **2.4** In line with paragraph 4.6 of the Framework Arrangement, UNICEF will apply 8% of the contribution towards UNICEF's indirect programme support costs in accordance with the Executive Board decision on UNICEF's cost recovery policy (2013/5) adopted on February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

# 3. Administration of the contribution

**3.1** The contribution covers a duration of 12 months, starting from the date of signature of the Ministerial Decree.



- **3.2** The contribution shall be managed by UNICEF in accordance with its financial regulations and other applicable rules, procedures and practices pertaining to other resources (non-core).
- **3.3** The contribution shall be subject exclusively to the internal and external auditing procedures provided therein. If the External Auditors' audit opinion should include observations about the way the contribution is used, UNICEF commits to inform the DGD of it and to update the DGD of its answer and potential actions to correct the situation.
- **3.4** Any modification of the present agreement or its annexes shall be officially requested to the Director General of the DGD and must receive its written approval.
- **3.5** Ownership of equipment, supplies and other property financed from the contribution shall be vested in UNICEF. Matters relating to the transfer of ownership by UNICEF shall be determined in accordance with the relevant policies and procedures of UNICEF.

# 4. Justification, reporting and refunding

- **4.1** UNICEF shall justify the use of these funds by providing narrative annual reports and financial reports, as stipulated in paragraph 8.1 and 8.3 of the Framework Arrangement signed on September 23, 2016. These reports shall be made in accordance with the Statutes of the organization.
- **4.2** Furthermore, UNICEF shall provide an individual 'Confirmation of Expenses' statement for this contribution of 2.500.000 EUR.
- **4.3** UNICEF commits to inform the DGD in case of suspected active or passive fraud or corruption as well as the measures the organization has taken in to mitigate and resolve the identified problem.
- **4.4** Given the humanitarian nature of the contribution, any unspent balances at the time of the financial closing of the project will be transferred to UNICEF's Global Humanitarian Thematic Fund and reported on accordingly.

# 5. Visibility, interpretation and dispute

- **5.1** Where appropriate and in line with its rules, UNICEF refer to the contribution with regards to the project or its activities in publications, speeches, press releases or similar communications.
- **5.2** Any dispute concerning the interpretation or implementation of the contribution shall be settled by negotiation, as agreed upon by UNICEF and DGD.
- **5.3** If, any time, a Party determines that the purpose of this letter can no longer be effectively or appropriately carried out, the present arrangement may be terminated at the initiative of either UNICEF or DGD giving thirty days written notice, in accordance with the procedure provided for by paragraph 7.5 of the Framework Arrangement signed on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2016. Contractual obligations entered into



force between UNICEF and any third party prior to the receipt of the notice of termination, shall not be affected by the termination.

# 6. Consultation

- **6.1** UNICEF shall provide the representatives of the Federal Public Service of Foreign Affairs, Foreign Trade and Development Co-operation, on request and within the frame of UNICEF's rules and regulations, with every information concerning the use of the contribution and the progress of the project.
- **6.2** UNICEF shall grant donor representative(s) access to project site(s) with the approval of the recipient government. Timing of such visits will be agreed by all parties. The costs of such participation will be borne by the donor. UNICEF assumes no responsibility or liability for the life, safety or property of visitors to its field offices, who are advised to carry appropriate insurance.
